Principal's Report (T. Aerts)	Happenings: "Guys and Dolls" school musical was very successful. May 11th to 14th 50th reunion Organizing committee requested a PAC contribution of \$1500 to help cover the live and canned music for the celebration. Motion: "The PAC will provide \$1000 in funds (out of the Operating Account) to the 50th Reynolds Reunion. The funds arising from the PAC share (50%) of any profit from the alumni dance will go to the school to be split between funding the alumni event and the school electronic sign (corner of Borden and MacKenzie), as the school determines." Mahia Frost moved and Ruth Simpson seconded. Motion passed. 4-day event: Thursday evening – recognition of alumni and staff who have made a difference in the community – by invitation only. Friday evening – open house tour – no tickets needed Saturday evening - dance in the gym. Need parent volunteers, including those with the required certification for serving alcohol. Please contact the school. Sunday – Mother's Day concert just outside of school (not in Playfair Park this year). A group of music students is in England. A group of 14 French immersion just left for France and Spain with Ms. Puckett. Junior band is now going to Calgary rather than San Francisco. Soccer program is still going to San Diego as they had already paid no- refundable plane fares. The school sent out a School District Enrolment Priorities Survey open until April 10th. The results will be extremely important for how your student progresses through the school system. The goal is to have 1000 parents participate; students are also encouraged to do so. Chair's Report (S. Vos)	 PAC AGM and elections - April 6th.
