Extra Grad Tickets

Extra tickets for the Reynolds High School 2019 Graduation on June 18th will go on sale **Thursday May 2nd 2019 starting at 9am**. Tickets can only be purchased over the phone, **250-721-8480** or in person from the UVic Ticket Centre. There will not be any tickets available online or at Reynolds School.

As there is a limited number of extra tickets each graduate is entitled to up to 3 tickets only. If there are any additional tickets remaining after this sale they will be available on a first come first serve basis the day of the ceremony.

Tickets must be booked in the student's name and all tickets will only be emailed to the email on file (no printed tickets will be given even for in-person sales). Under no circumstances will a new email be added to the student file.

Tickets are \$10 each (+ a \$2.00 fee on the transaction). Extra tickets are limited to 3 per student on a first come first served basis.

SATURDAY MAY 25th - DINNER DANCE AND PEARKES REC CENTRE/SILVER CITY AFTER-GRAD

Dinner Dance - Inn at Laurel Point. Tickets will be on sale in the school office for this event starting Thursday, May 2nd until Friday May 17th at a cost of \$80. Grads are welcome to arrive at the Inn at Laurel Point anytime between 6:00 and 6:30pm. Dinner is served at 7pm and there will be a grad slideshow and dance following. The dinner dance ends at 11:00 pm. Many students meet at the legislative assembly building (around 5pm) before the dinner dance for photos. This photo session is not an officially organized school event but one that has happened over the last number of years.

Pearkes Rec Centre Silver City After-Grad - Students must sign up for this free event ahead of time. They will be bussed from The Laurel Point at 11:00 pm to Tillicum Mall. The grads will have a grad skate followed by going to Silver City. Once there, students will receive free video games, a free pop and popcorn and then their choice of one of three free movies. Students are responsible for getting home on their own after the movies, roughly at 2:30 am.

There may be other events taking place over the coming weeks but please know that those listed above are the only school-sanctioned grad events.
