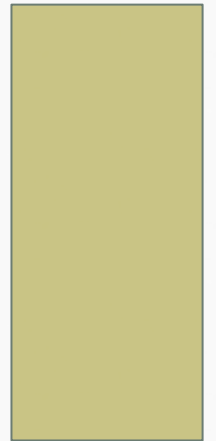

Ceremony Tickets

- Ceremony tickets are SOLD OUT but a waitlist is being taken at UVIC.
- Some tickets are released back to the venue, guests, staff, change in plans
- Last minute tickets available the day of ceremony at box office, first come first serve

- No in and out privileges

- 20% reduction in ticket price (\$65) refunds available in office

GOWNS

 - for example - R42 S59 or L74 S88

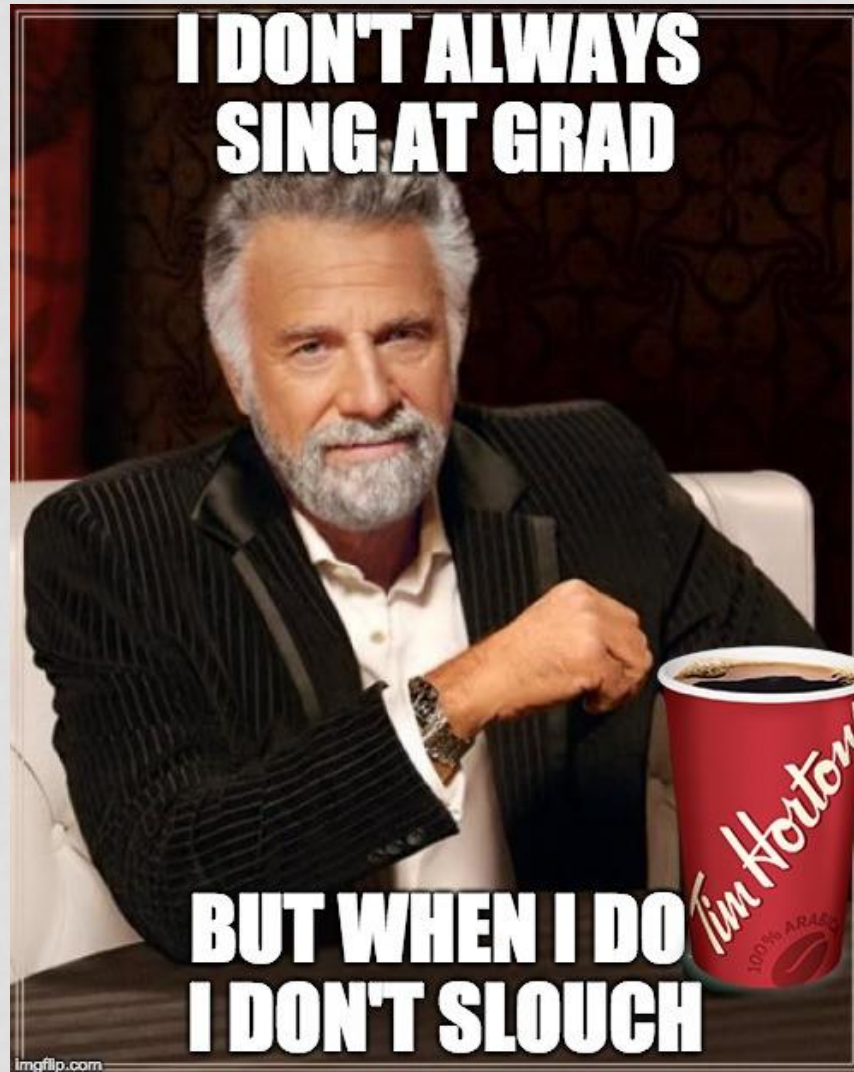
