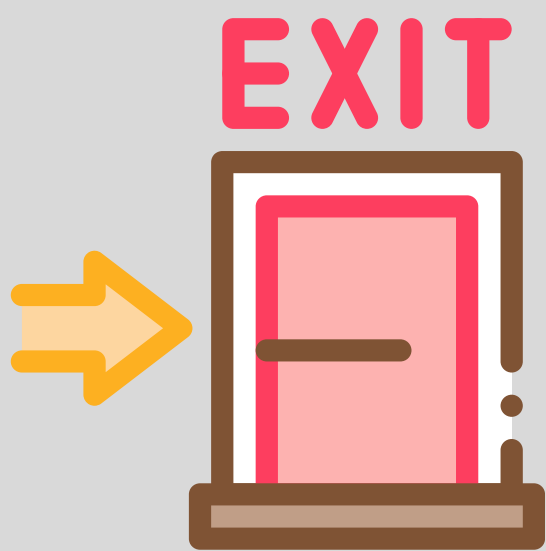


# REYNOLDS SECONDARY SCHOOL 2020-2021 LUNCHTIME PROTOCOLS: FIRST HALF OF QUARTER

## SCENARIO 1: STUDENT DOES NOT HAVE AN AFTERNOON CLASS

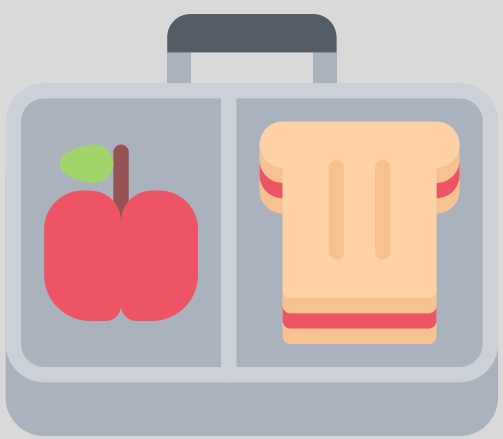


Student is dismissed from their AB block and must **leave the building** for the day.

Students are reminded to physically distance and wear masks as needed in community.

## SCENARIO 2: STUDENT HAS AN AFTERNOON CLASS

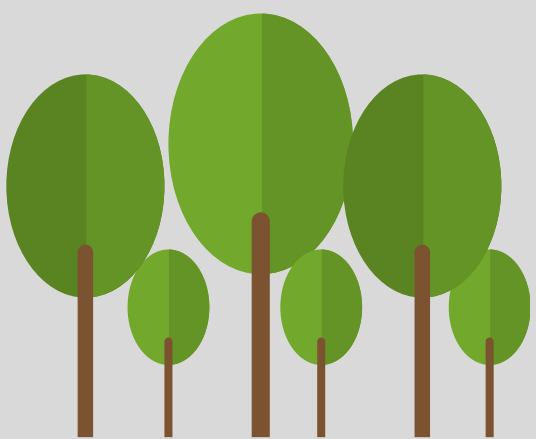


Student is dismissed from their AB block at 11:30am and **must go to their CD class** to eat lunch. Students remain **in their CD classroom** for the duration of lunch hour.

Where the CD classroom is not available (ie shop, computer lab, PE), an alternate lunch space will be provided. As the CD class is the cross learning group, **students are required to physically distance.**

## SCENARIO 3: STUDENT DOES NOT WANT TO SPEND LUNCH IN THEIR CD CLASSROOM

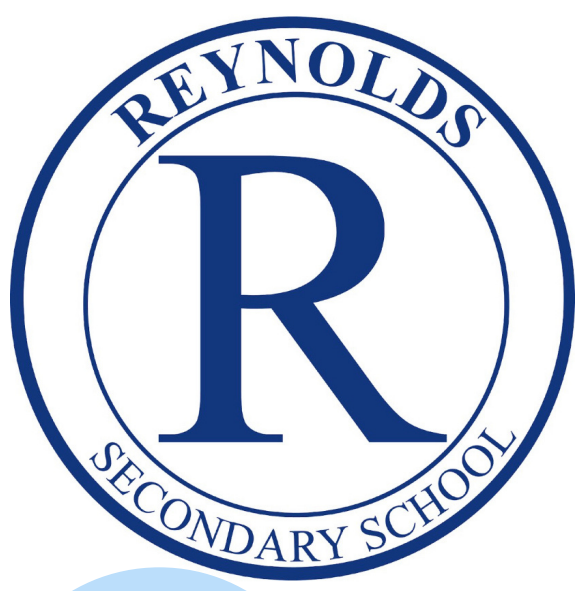


Student is dismissed from their AB block at 11:30am and **may leave the building. A student may enter the building to go directly to their CD class.**

Where the CD classroom is not available (ie shop, computer lab, PE), an alternate lunch space will be provided. If the CD class is the cross learning group, **students are required to physically distance.**



- These health and safety protocols ensure that students are **not in the hallways** during lunch time. Students with afternoon classes may choose between options 2 and 3 each day.
- EAs will provide supervision of the classrooms on a roaming basis.
- Teachers may be in their classrooms during lunchtime but are not required to provide instruction or supervision.
- Students are reminded that when outside of school they are expected to physically distance with students outside their learning group as per Provincial guidelines and remember Reynolds' Three Rs: Respect, Responsibility and Relationships.

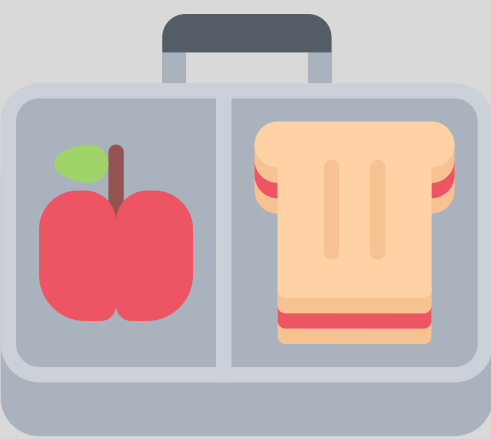
## SCENARIO 1: STUDENT DOES NOT HAVE AN MORNING CLASS

## SCENARIO 2: STUDENT HAS A MORNING CLASS

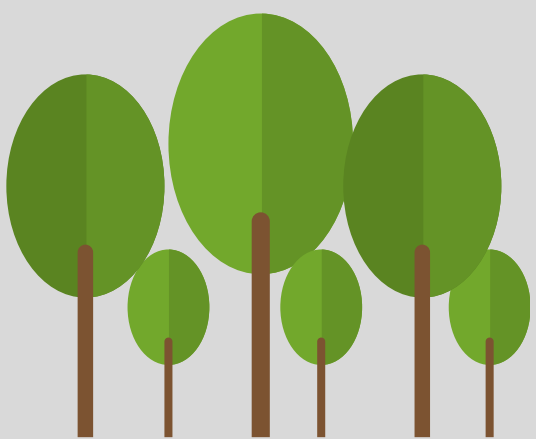


Student is dismissed from their AB block at 11:30am and **must go to their CD class to eat lunch. Students remain in their CD classroom for the duration of lunch hour.**
