Player and Parent/Guardian Statements

Applicants and their Parent/Guardian are required to **include a brief statement about the applicant and indicate their reasons for applying** (on the forms provided).

Report Card

Applicants are required to include a copy of the **most recent progress report/interim report** in the application package.

Program Costs

Similar to extra-curricular programs and curricular programs with an extra-curricular or co-curricular component, there will be costs associated with the program that families are expected to pay. The costs are as follows: (\$1000)

- Honoraria for Guest Coaches and Instructors: \$450
- Supplies and Player Equipment: \$250
- Player Transportation: \$75
- Program Administration: \$75
- Facility Costs: \$150

Athletic Eligibility

BC School Sports and **LVISSA** (Lower Vancouver Island Secondary School Athletic Association) eligibility rules apply to students entering Reynolds from Grade 9-12.

Students who transfer to Reynolds after Grade 9 are subject to specific regulations that may affect eligibility.
