
Important Dates

- We will stop ticket sales on Friday, December 1st
- Tickets will be available to purchase in person starting at lunch on Tuesday, November 21st
- Guest tickets must be purchased in person from Ms. Kirzinger
- We reserve the right to limit the number of guest tickets

Seat Selection

For the dinner portion, grads and guests will sit at assigned tables. Each table has 6 seats. Students are able to sign up for a specific table with their friends starting at lunch on Tuesday, November 21st.

After you have purchased your ticket, you will be given a sticker with your name on it. You then place your sticker on a "table" on the bulletin board.

If you purchase your ticket online, you can show your receipt to claim your name sticker.

Students who do not place their own sticker at a table will be assigned a seat.

Students will be able to request to have a table placed near another table.

All grads must join the Grad Google Classroom to receive important information about their Career Life Connections course and other grad events and information. The code is a i 4 q d v x

Grad Requirements

Students must be in the position to meet the BC Ministry of Education graduation requirements at the <u>Term 3 report card</u>, or they may not be eligible to participate in the recognition ceremony. Students must be meeting graduation requirements on the April report card, have written the Literacy 10, Literacy 12 and Numeracy Assessments and be at least 50% through any distributed learning courses.

Our counsellors Ms. Leahy (students with last name A –D) Ms. Flater (students with last name E-L) and Mr. Loukes (last name M-Z) or Mr. Sitar (International Students) can assist in answering any questions regarding graduation status.

The requirements for graduation in BC are found <u>here</u>. Please keep in mind that these are the requirements to graduate high school; post secondary institutions may have entrance requirements above and beyond.



Numeracy and Literacy Assessments

Grads of 2024 are required to have completed the **Numeracy 10** Assessment, the **Literacy 10** Assessment and the **Literacy 12** Assessment. If you have not written the Numeracy or Literacy 10 Assessments yet, you need to speak with Vice Principal Ms. Kirzinger as soon as possible.

All grade 12s will be scheduled to write the Literacy 12 Assessment during Assessment Palooza on November 1^{st} and 2^{nd} .



Financial Planning

Approximate Costs of Grad. These costs are estimates and subject to change.

Grad Fee- \$65- Gowns, Ceremony rental, Certificates. Please **pay now** via the Reynolds website School Cash Online.

- Guest tickets for ceremony- \$12 per ticket. Ceremony reception & rental no cost for participants
- Winter Formal Dinner/Dance- approx. \$65 per ticket.
- Spring Dinner Dance/ "Prom" approx. \$100 per ticket

Career Life Connections

CLC is a 4-credit course **required for graduation** in BC. It culminates in a Capstone project.

What is the Capstone?

A research project on something you are interested in learning about. Explore your topic in three ways: **Research**: use Youtube, websites, books.

Connect: find a mentor who can listen to you and give guidance or advice.

Lived Experience: Find a way to experience what you are learning about

There are Capstone examples in the Google Classroom.

The first Capstone assignment is due October 15th.

Our CLC teachers will be visiting B block classrooms the week of September $18^{th} - 21^{st}$ to provide information and answer questions.



Life After Reynolds

Post-secondary does not always mean university or college. For some it means volunteering, travelling and/or working. Whatever it is, we are here to support you as you start that journey.

Applying to post-secondary can be a complicated process - make sure you read all instructions carefully and check your email regularly. We are here to help you, but ultimately the responsibility is yours to apply and follow up with your institutions.



Student Transcript Service (STS)

There is a VERY IMPORTANT process for ordering and sending transcripts to post-secondary institutions. Students proceeding to post-secondary <u>MUST</u> complete this process to have transcripts sent. **You can do this now.**

If you need INTERIM grades sent **prior to February**, transcripts (both electronic and hardcopy) need to be ordered from the office (please specify that they need to include interim grades).
