

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Reynolds Lunch Program - February to March

The first month of our lunch program with Flourish! School Food Society has been a huge success and we are excited to continue to offer it to our school community. It has been great to see students' smiling faces as we have been offering hot, delicious, fresh food. Our primary goal is to provide food for those students and families who need it cost free. It will continue to be available for those students and families that need it and you do not need to do anything to continue to access this service.

In addition, this service is open to all students in our school and is available for purchase if you are interested. Families indicated that they would be interested in signing up for a partial service. There are 2 options available for purchase: 5 days a week and 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday). Please see the options below. We require students to be registered so we can ensure we have enough food. The cost is \$7.00 per meal.

Option 1 - 5 days per week (February 5th - March 15th)

• 28 meals @ \$7 = \$196

Option 2 - 3 days per week Monday/Wednesday/Friday (February 5th - March 15th)

• 16 meals @ \$7 = \$112
