Saanich Road Safety Action Plan:



Dear Stakeholder,

We are excited to share that the District of Saanich is creating a [Road Safety Action Plan](#). This is in response to District Council adopting **Vision Zero** as the new approach to road safety in Saanich in February 2022.

Vision Zero is an ambitious goal to eliminate all traffic injuries and fatalities while ensuring safe, healthy, and equitable mobility for all road users. This includes people who walk, ride a bike, take a bus or drive. **Vision Zero** is a new paradigm for road safety that recognizes that human error is inevitable, and a systems-based approach (called a Safe-Systems approach) is needed to ensure that actions targeted to achieve safe speed limits, safe road design, safe people and safe vehicles work together to achieve this aim.

The **Road Safety Action Plan** will be developed over 17 months and focus on collecting and analyzing data to understand the risks and impacts of collisions; identifying targets and actions; and the creation of an implementation and monitoring plan to prioritize and track our progress.

Stakeholder and public involvement is an important part of the planning process. To ensure that the **Road Safety Action Plan** addresses the varied needs of our diverse community, the District, in partnership with Urban Systems, will be hosting an in-person stakeholder workshop on March 14, 2023, from 2:30 to 5:30pm at the Cedar Hill Golf Course. You have been identified as a community representative who would add great value to the discussion. The format of the workshop will include opening remarks from Mayor Murdock followed by an overview presentation and small group discussions.

We kindly ask that you RSVP by March 10, 2023, using the link below. Seating is limited so a maximum of two (2) participants from your organization can register at this time. If you have more participants who wish to attend, contact megan.squires@saanich.ca to add their names and emails to the waiting list. Individuals will be contacted as spaces become available. If you are unable to attend, there will be other opportunities for input this spring.
