Ticket Sales

- Grads do not need a ticket for themselves.
- All tickets are emailed to the email address given in the Google Form prior to spring break
- If you did not register an email address and have a gown ordered, you won't be able to purchase tickets
- Tickets can be printed or presented on a mobile device with the barcode easily scanned
- Babies, even if being held, must have a ticket to enter the venue
- Tickets will be emailed closer to the ceremony date

ROUND ONE ticket sales

- April 15th May 3rd, 2024
- Tickets available through School Cash Online or with Accounts Clerk in cash
- o \$12 each
- Each grad may purchase up to 3 tickets
- Students must have completed the form to register their email address prior to purchasing tickets (form submitted before spring break)
- o If you require special seating (wheelchair, walker, etc) please email Ms. Kirzinger at emkirzinger@sd61.bc.ca prior to May 3rd 2024
- Seats will be assigned based on the order sold; all seats at UVic have a good view of the stage

ROUND TWO ticket sales

- After each grad has the opportunity to purchase up to 3 tickets in round one, the rest of the tickets will be sold
- o Round Two Ticket sales will begin May 27th 2024 until we sell out
- o \$12 each
- o Round Two tickets are on a first come, first sold basis
- Round Two tickets are sold **only** through the UVIC box office in person or over the phone (no online sales)
- Tickets purchased during round 2 will not be seated next to tickets purchased in round one

- Saturday, May 25th 2024 at the Delta Ocean Point
- Tickets on sale May 6th 16th via school
- Tickets expected to cost around \$100+ each
- At least \$85 of that price covers the venue and meal;
 the rest covers music, incidentals, etc... we do not profit from this event
- O May 6th 13th Reynolds Grade 12 students only
- O May 14th 16th Guest ticket sales, space permitting
- Guests will need approval prior to purchasing tickets
 - o Guest forms available April 29th and must be submitted before May 4th
- Venue has limited capacity; we may not be able to accommodate all guest requests
- Participation is optional and students must be in good standing to attend

Grad Requirements

Students must be in the position to meet the BC Ministry of Education graduation requirements at the <u>Term 3 report card</u>, or they may not be eligible to participate in the recognition ceremony. Students must be meeting graduation requirements on the April report card, have written the Literacy 10, Literacy 12 and Numeracy Assessments and be at least 50% through any distributed learning courses.

Our counsellors Ms. Leahy (students with last name A –L) and Mr. Loukes (last name M-Z) or Mr. Sitar (International Students) can assist in answering any questions regarding graduation status.

The requirements for graduation in BC are found <u>here</u>. Please keep in mind that these are the requirements to graduate high school; post secondary institutions may have entrance requirements above and beyond.
