Reynolds Lunch Program – October

With our lunch program fully underway we are continuing to offer lunch provided from Flourish. Our primary goal is to provide food for those students and families who need it cost free. In addition, this service is open to all students in our school and is available for purchase if you are interested. The cost is \$7.00 per meal. We do require students to have registered ahead to ensure that we have enough food.

Dates for October: Oct. 1 - October 31.
21 meals plus transaction fee = \$153.70

Please sign up for the Reynolds lunch program by Wednesday Sept. 27th through your student's School Cash Online account. If finances are a barrier, please continue to read below.

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Support Block Guidelines

WHAT IS SUPPORT BLOCK?

Support Block is time offered to provide students with choice and time to support their learning at Reynolds. Support Block is time for students to work with educators to make up or retake tests/quizzes/assignments, get help with assignments and projects, have time for homework completion, work on group projects, etc. For Support Block to be effective, students must make good choices on how to best use their time. Teachers may schedule appointments with students during Support Block and students are expected to attend.

STAFF COLLABORATION

Once a month during support time, teachers may elect to collaborate with other staff members. Providing opportunities for staff to collaborate within the school day on a regular basis leads to improved teaching strategies for staff and more effective learning for students. Teachers will communicate with students regarding support block availability.

EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Support block provides students with an opportunity to decide what class they need support in. Students can decide each week where to go.
- It is instructional time. The school day on the support block day ends at 3:05pm.
- Teachers may ask students on an individual basis to attend support block and students are expected to attend
 - If a student does not attend support block when asked to, the teacher may communicate with student and follow up with parent/guardian as necessary

EMERGING

An Emerging student is required to attend support block because they missed learning opportunities or do not know/understand the curricular competencies for the course. An emergent student needs to be directed how to use their support block time. The teacher directs how a student should use their support block time.

DEVELOPING

A Developing student may also be required to attend support block because they may have missed some learning opportunities and/or have partially shown understanding of some of the curricular competencies for the course. The teacher recommends how a student should use their support block time.

PROFICIENT

A Proficient student is meeting the curricular competencies for the course and may choose to utilize support time to complete or extend learning opportunities. A proficient student may use support block as individual work time.

EXTENDING

An Extending student is fully meeting/exceeding the curricular competencies for the course and may choose to utilize support block for self directed study or may choose to be off campus during support block. These students may be able to assist emerging or developing learners.
