# Appendix A - Reynolds PAC Treasurer's Report October 2024

### 1. 2023/24 Year-End Financial Statement & Account Balances

- Our fiscal year runs July 1 June 30. The <u>attached year-end financial statement</u> summarizes our starting position at the beginning of the 2023/24 fiscal year, revenue, budgeted expenditures, actual expenditures, and our end-of-year balances.
- There are three main (& separate) PAC accounts, with distinct purposes/rules.

Staff submit requests for funding to PAC for review/approval.  | Starting = \$4,496.52<br>Ending = \$19,925.85 | \$3,884.27                         | The majority of approved 2023/24 expense claims were submitted late in the year, so the cheques did not clear our account until the 2024/25 fiscal year.  |
| School Online Donation Account  Online donations from school community. Account is held in trust by SD61 (i.e., we must go through the school's Account Clerk to get updated balances & reimbursement). | Starting = \$2,440.00<br>Ending = \$642.18    | \$2,917.00                         | In 2023/24, the online donation form specifically said for "staff appreciation", so we were generous with staff appreciation in 2023/24. That stipulation was removed in 2024/25 so we have more flexibility in how we allocate these funds this year.  |



### 2. Gaming Grant Funding

- 2023 Gaming Grant Report has been submitted.
- 2024 application was submitted in May. Application status = Complete.
- Funding request form has been distributed to Reynolds staff. Deadline for fall funding requests is October 28; requests will be reviewed by PAC members (Maryse, Marc, Jessica, Pauline, Hanne, and anyone else who wants to join!) that night. Goal is to present recommendations for approval at the November PAC meeting. Contact any PAC Exec if you'd like to participate in the process of review & developing recommendations.

#### 3. BCCPAC Membership Fee

\$100 membership fee for <u>BC Confederation of Parent Advisory Councils</u> is due. As per current guidelines, BCCPAC membership fees qualify as an eligible use of Gaming Grant funds.

"BCCPAC represents parents at the provincial level, providing direct feedback and engaging in dialogue on behalf of our members. Members are able to become involved in committees, provide input throughout the year, request guidance from our staff or Board, stay informed about current and emerging issues within public education and engage in the democratic process of elections and resolutions which help guide BCCPAC's priorities.
