References

Student and Parent/Guardian Statements

Applicants and their Parent/Guardian are required to include a brief statement about the applicant and indicate their reasons for applying (on the forms provided).

Learning Update (Progress Report)

Applicants are required to include a copy of the **most recent progress report** in the application package.

Program Costs

Similar to extra-curricular programs and curricular programs with an extra-curricular or co-curricular component, there will be costs associated with the program that families are expected to pay. **The cost is \$1100** (+ SD61 transaction fees)*.

The cost covers the following:

- Honoraria for Guest Coaches and Instructors
- Supplies, equipment and student CSE gear.
- Player Transportation
- Program Administration
- Facility Costs

Athletic Eligibility

BC School Sports eligibility rules apply to students entering Reynolds from Grades 9-12. BCSS rules state that **all out of catchment students** participating in sport specific academies are **ineligible to participate on the school extracurricular team in the specific sport of the academy** (for Reynolds, school soccer). These students are eligible to play any other extracurricular school sports at Reynolds.
