Did you know...? Getting to school on time is important:

An ask from your school team.....

We have been noticing a trend of students arriving late to class especially during the first block of the day. Teachers report some days they have as low as 50% of their students in class and ready to learn by the second bell.

We understand the importance of sleep for teenagers but we also know that missing instructional time is problematic. Factors such as the city bus schedule can be a challenge; however, if we can start with simply encouraging your student to arrive on-time we hope that it will make a difference as it truly takes a team.

Beginning in semester two all students that do not have a pre-excused late for any of our four blocks will need to sign in at the office if they are 30 minutes or more late for class. We do understand that students may have various reasons for being late; however, once a student has not attended class for a 30 minute period of time or greater they will be considered absent. Students will then be required to sign in and a notification will be sent home. Students will then be given a pass to present to their classroom teacher .

This is a slight shift in procedure that we will continually monitor to see if there is an impact.



Calling for library returns or renewals ASAP!

If your students have checked Library out books for silent reading/ individual reading/ a class project this semester, or if they have textbooks they are no longer using, it would be most appreciated if they could come by and renew or return these books ASAP. There are over 300 overdue books that need to be returned or renewed.
