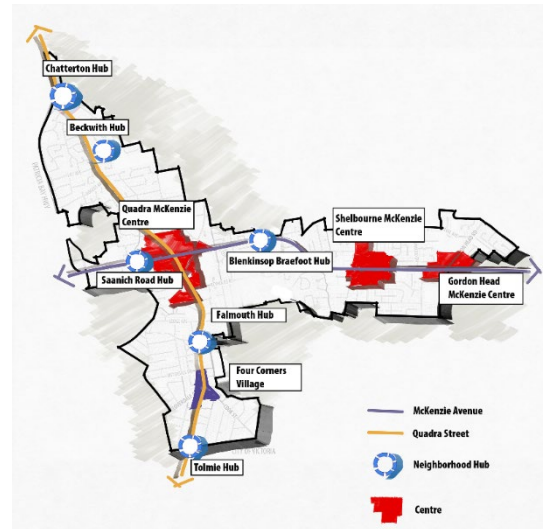

Reynolds-Lasalle Storm Drain and Watermain Upgrades

What's happening?

The District of Saanich is commencing construction for a storm drain main and watermain upgrade project on Reynolds Road and Lasalle Street. The first phase of this work will be the storm main along Lasalle Street and Reynolds Road, followed by watermain works along Reynolds Road.

Why are we doing this?

The existing storm drain has been determined to require replacement due to condition and recent failures in the area. Watermain replacement is due to increased capacity requirements.

Project Impacts

Vehicle access will be impacted by single lane alternating traffic. Traffic control personnel and signage will be in-place to help direct vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians through the work areas. Construction work will take place between Monday-Friday.
