<u>Did you know? Why did I stop getting emails when I installed the Reynolds App?</u>

If you were receiving email notifications before you installed/signed in to the app, you may stop receiving those emails now that you can receive push notifications. In that case, if you wish to continue receiving notifications by email as well, you can enable that in the app.

From the Home screen, tap the User Settings icon (just to the right of your name). Then, tap

Account & Notifications. Tap to see the options under Email Notifications and choose Yes or one of the other options. Then tap Save Changes.
