## **Absences/Lates:**

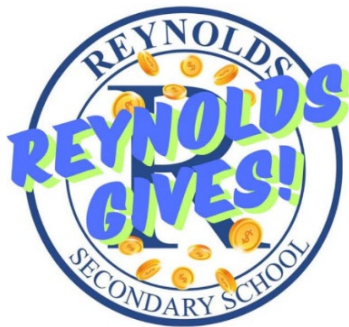
