Reynolds Road Raised Crosswalks and 40km/h Speed Limit Implementation

What's happening?

The District of Saanich is undertaking a transportation project following the Reynolds-Lasalle Storm Sewer and Watermain Upgrade project in the winter / spring of 2026.

Crews will install 40km/h Speed Limit Signs from Quadra Street to Cedar Hill Cross Road and two new raised crosswalks: one at the intersection of Cumberland Road and Reynolds Road, and one at Lasalle Street and Reynolds Road. Both crossings will be equipped with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons.

March 2026 Update: the District will complete paving of Reynolds Road between Cumberland Road and Cedar Hill Cross Road in conjunction with the construction of Raised Crosswalks this March. Paving work is anticipated to take place at the end of March. Please subscribe to the Reynolds project page on our Hello.Saanich website for further updates.

Project Impacts

Residents can expect crews to be on site daily during construction. Crews will provide the necessary traffic control to complete their work safely.
